

Employee Guide to CPS' COVID-19 Vaccination Rollout

What to Expect When Getting COVID-19 Vaccinations

This two-part Pfizer vaccine series is provided by the Cincinnati Health Department. You will receive the first and second parts of the vaccine about 21 days apart (+/- 4 days).

Before Receiving Vaccinations

- **Masks covering the nose and mouth are required at vaccination sites.**
- As possible, stay 6 feet away from others at vaccination sites.
- **Wear an appropriate shirt**
 - The vaccination shot is given in the upper-arm muscle. Wear short sleeves or long sleeves that can be pushed up easily.
- **Didn't preregister / don't have an appointment?**

Please do not go to a vaccination site without an appointment from the Health Department.

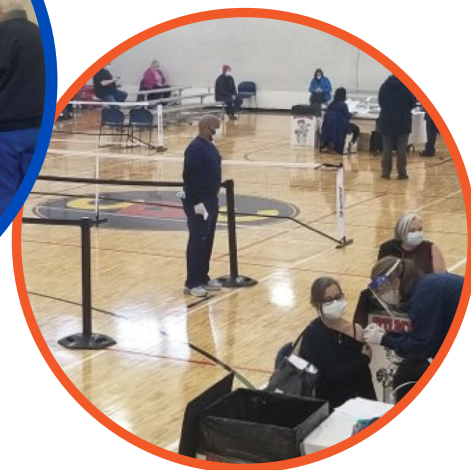
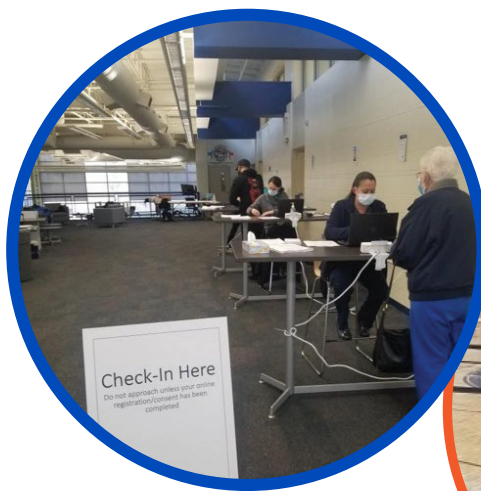
Arriving at Vaccination Location

- Arrive **ON TIME** (not early, please) to your vaccination appointment.
- Your temperature will be taken by a Health Department representative.
- If your temperature is in normal range, go to the check-in tables.
- You will receive
 - A vaccination card noting which COVID-19 vaccine you received, the date received and site location.
 - A fact sheet with specific information about the COVID-19 vaccine you are receiving, with information about risks and benefits.



Getting Vaccinated

- After check-in, you will be directed into a specific line to receive your vaccination.

After Vaccination

You will be asked to wait 15 minutes in a designated and monitored area inside the building to ensure that any allergic reactions are tended to.

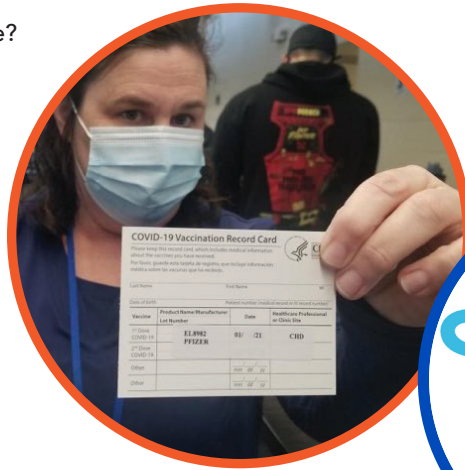
Some people may require 30 minutes of monitoring, including those with a history of an immediate allergic reaction to vaccines or injectable therapy, a history of anaphylaxis, or if you are pregnant, immunocompromised or are taking medications that affect the immune system.

Continue to Follow Public Health Guidance

Even after you receive both vaccine doses, it is critical to continue following public health guidance: Wear a mask covering your nose and mouth, maintain social distance, and wash hands often.
